

The stage is officially set for the 2025 UEFA Champions League Final: Inter Milan vs Paris Saint-Germain in Munich on May 31st. Two very different footballing identities, one massive prize on the line.

From a coaching perspective, this is a fascinating matchup. Inter Milan has quietly and effectively battled their way to the final, showing incredible organization, discipline, and belief. Their dramatic semi-final win over Barcelona showcased their maturity and tactical awareness—qualities we emphasize in our own training sessions.

On the other side, PSG has undergone a significant transformation.
